YOU DON'T HAVE A RESIDENCE PERMIT?

- You are entitled to legal protection and to be defended by a lawyer.
- You are entitled to urgent medical assistance: you can go to the emergency room in case of an accident or injury.
- You can have basic medical care and get a temporary medical card (STP)*.
- You cannot have an employment contract.
- You cannot open a bank account.

IN ITALY YOU ARE ENTITLED TO:



*The STP card is issued to foreigners present on Italian territory by the health district.

DO YOU HAVE A RESIDENCE PERMIT?

- You are entitled to legal protection and to be defended by a lawyer.
- You are entitled to all medical care (including specialist care), you can get a health card.
- You are entitled to a regular employment contract.
- You are entitled to open a bank account.
- With an expired residence permit and an appointment at the Police Station for renewal, you can conclude or renew a work contract.

IN ITALY YOU ARE ENTITLED TO:



Some residence permits allow entry into reception and integration projects (SAI).

DID YOU APPLY FOR ASYLUM?

- You are entitled to legal protection and to be defended by a lawyer.
- You are entitled to all medical care (including specialist care), you can get a health card.
- You are entitled to open a bank account.
- You can conclude an employment contract, but only after 60 days of your asylum application.
- You are entitled to reception in asylum seeker centres.*

IN ITALY YOU ARE ENTITLED TO:



*You can request reception in an Extraordinary Reception Centre or an SAI project (only for some specific vulnerabilities).
